



Limited Lockdown Competitions at Leatherhead

With the further easing of lockdown restrictions and the opening of our green we have the opportunity to inject a little more competitiveness back into our game. The committee have agreed to suspend the normal competitions until next year because not everyone is able to play so we are introducing a limited number of "Lockdown Competitions". **Entry is free** and for the most part the usual rules will apply. (Competition entry fees for this year will be carried over to next year.)

The competitions we propose running are:

1. For Men - Men's Lockdown Championship (singles)
2. For Ladies - Ladies's Lockdown Championship (singles)
3. Mixed - Mixed Lockdown Championship (singles)
4. Senior Lockdown Championship (singles members aged 70 and above)
5. 2 Wood Pairs Lockdown competition
6. Triples Lockdown competition

Schedule

Competition opens 21st June (earlier if possible)

All Singles Round 1 play by 12th July
Round 2 play by 26th July
Quarter Final round play by 9th August
Semi Final round play by 23rd August

Mixed 2 Wood pairs to be played on Saturday 25th July
Mixed Triples to be played on Saturday & Sunday 4th/5th July
Finals Weekend Saturday and Sunday 29th/30th August

Important additional rules and organisation:

- Social Distancing must be maintained at all times, on changing ends walk on both sides of the green. Only inspect a head one person at a time.
- Singles games will be organised by the challenger as usual. This includes appointing a marker. The marker will act as an umpire i.e he/she will be the only person to measure and during measures players must withdraw from the head. **Touchers to be marked with spray chalk only.**
- Mixed 2 wood pairs will be played in one of two sessions over 1 day with entrants split into either a morning session of 4 rounds or an afternoon one. The best 2 teams from each session to be drawn for a semi final to be played on a date(s) arranged by themselves.
- Mixed Triples will be played in one of two sessions to be played over 2 days. Entrants will play 4 rounds on 1 of those 2 days. The best 2 teams from each day to be drawn for a semi final to be played on a date(s) arranged by themselves.
- Scoreboards are not to be used. Markers/skips should keep teams aware of scores.
- Rinks to be booked either through the online booking system or by arrangement with the competition organisers who will book for players.
- Spectating is permitted provided safe distancing can be maintained. Spectators may be asked to leave if the competition organisers deem it necessary in order to comply with safe social distancing.
- Results to be shared by the winner via email or telephone call to the organisers within 24 hours of play. Keep any scorecards for later examination if necessary. **Completed scorecards should not be left at the club.**
- If a player/players are forced into self-isolation and cannot meet play-by dates they will unfortunately have to be eliminated from the competition.
- In any matter, a decision by the competition organisers is final
